Preparing students for the growing need for church worker or believer who is interested in ministry or theology.

Each student will be provided assistance to utilize his/her educational abilities for the self, community, and society at large.

Each degree program that is offered by St. Luke University (SLU) is designed to provide a student with the skills, ethics, and professionalism required to become a positive contributor within their community.

Admissions Process

Prospective students must contact the University to obtain an admissions packet. It is the applicant's responsibility to arrange for submission of transcripts from all secondary and post-secondary institutions they have previously attended.

Only official grade transcripts received directly from such institutions will be accepted. Applicants for admission to master's degree programs must arrange to provide SLU with transcripts and proof of graduation from undergraduate institutions; applicants to bachelor's degree programs and the ESL program must arrange to provide SLU with official high school transcripts and proof of graduation from high school or valid GED. The student must ensure that their TOEFL scores (if applicable) are submitted to the University. Students without a TOEFL score will be required to take and pass the St. Luke University English Language Proficiency exam. Once the student's application file is deemed complete, the Academic Dean's office will review the application.

Admission decisions will be made within 30 days of receiving all required documentation. Students will not be admitted to the school without the required documentation and registration fees.

Approvals

St. Luke University (SLU) is approved by the California Bureau for Private Postsecondary and Vocational Education (BPPVE) and Acupuncture Board (CAB). SLU is also authorized by the Student Exchange and Visitor Program (SEVP) to enroll non-immigrant students.

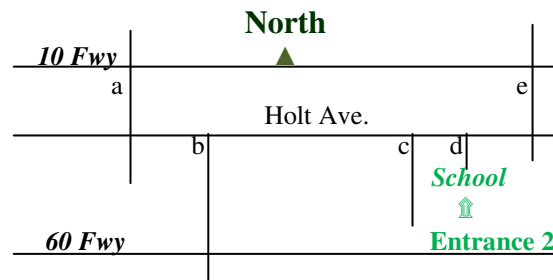
